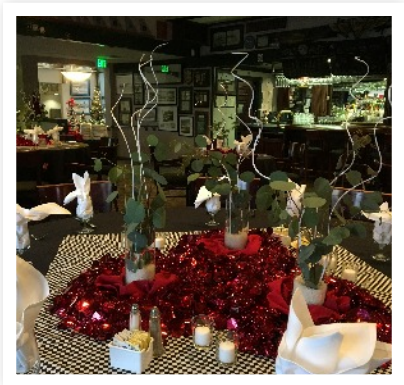

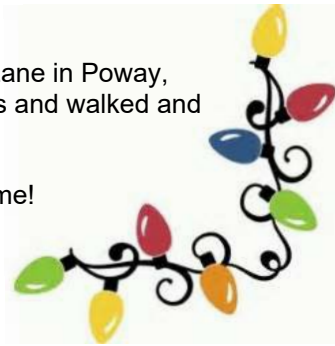


# Christmas Light Run December 14th
