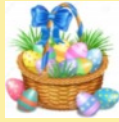

Nominations will open at the business meeting. The committee will solicit and accept nominations.

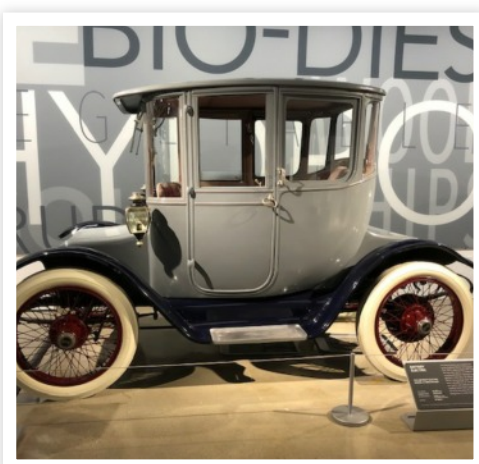
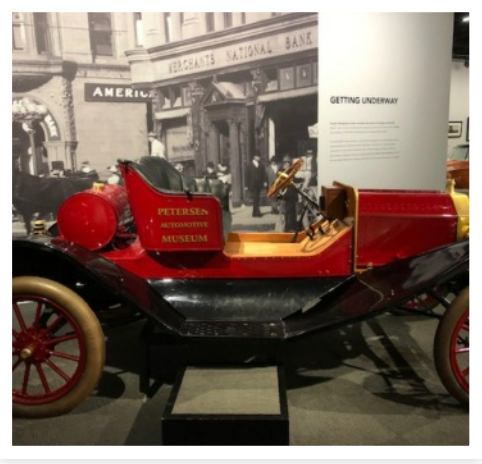
JUNE

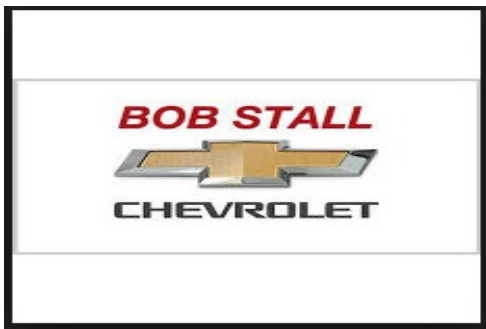
