Officers will commence their duties at the business meeting.

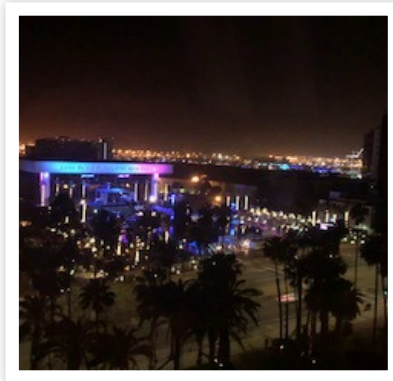

2019 Grand Prix of Long Beach

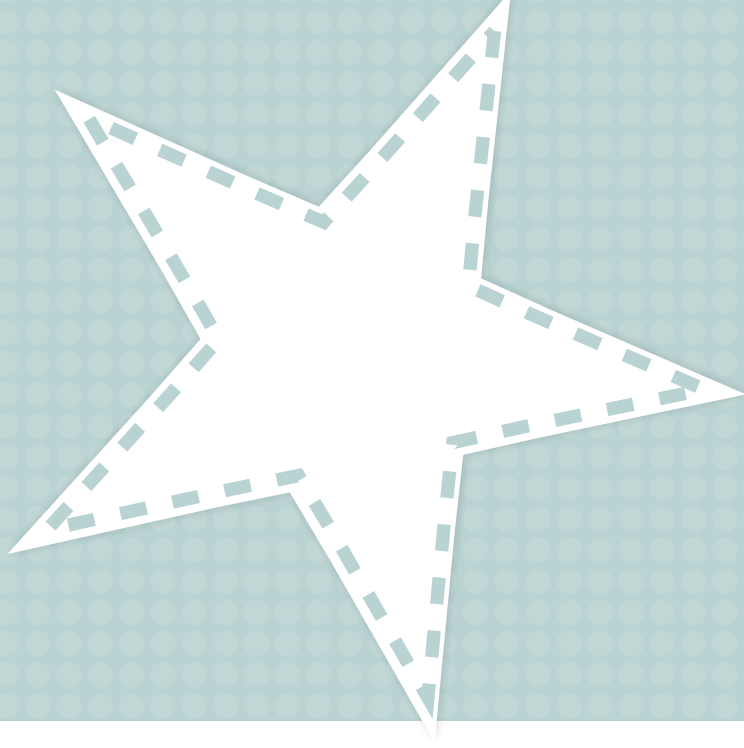
The Grand Prix of Long Beach, named the '#1 Street race in America' is a 1.968-mile, 12-turn circuit that encircles the Long Beach Convention Center
