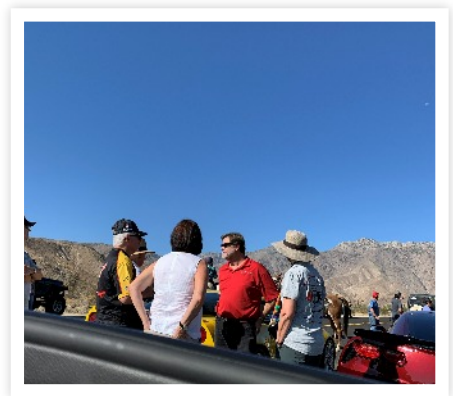

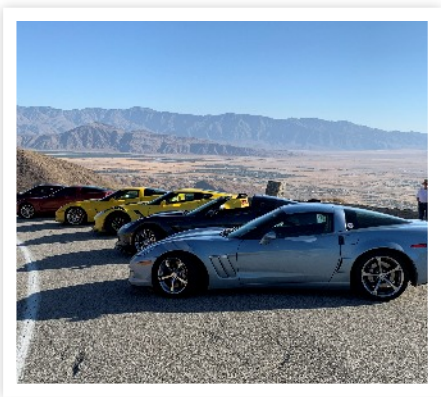
Congratulations Mike Hartman!

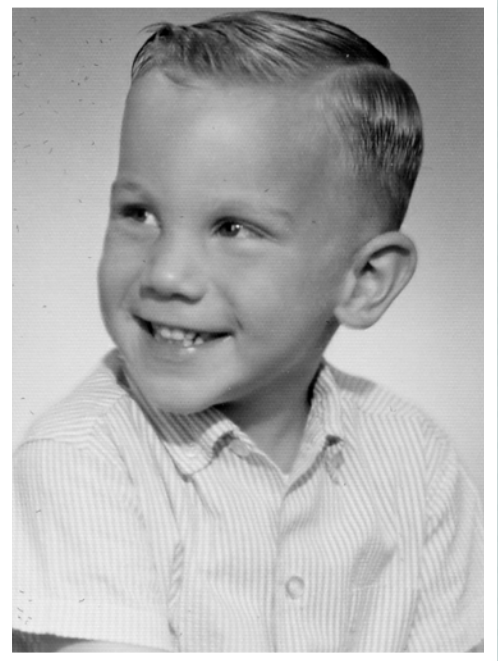
Tuesday Night Dinner and Movie

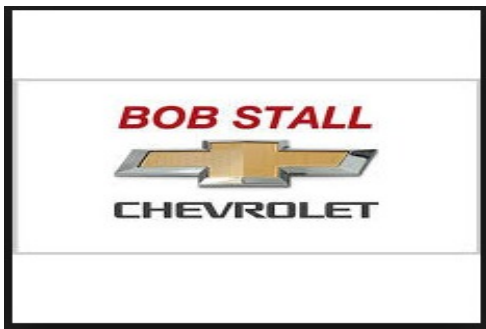
