NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM (NCM) REPORT


The National Corvette Museum is open for limited hours as we spend time with families. No events are planned; lots of goodies on sale for Christmas shopping.

Luncheon--Gift Exchange



Directions will follow closer to the event. Looking forward to seeing you soon.








