### **Monthly Unrun Meetup**

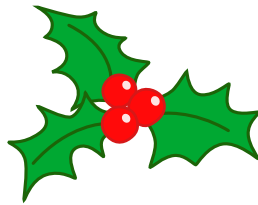

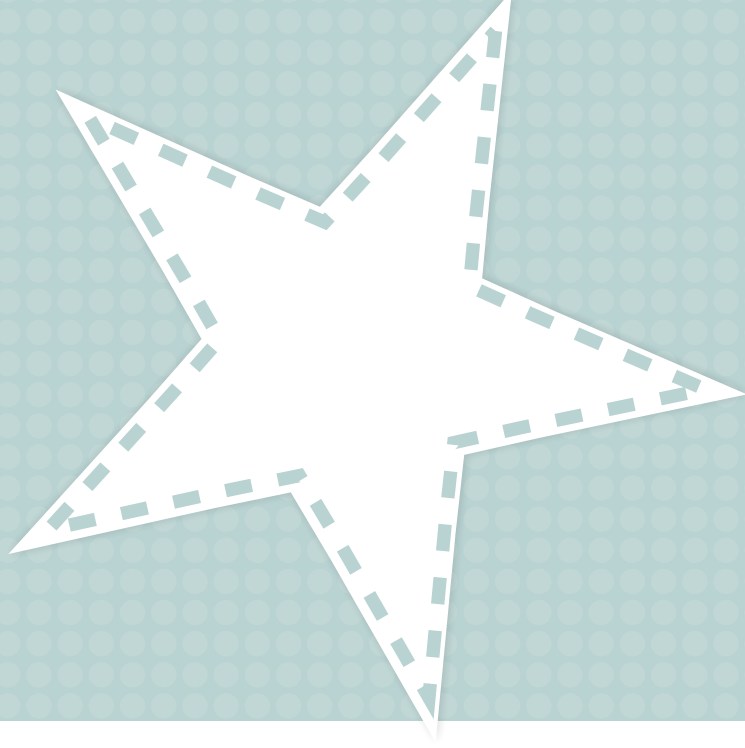
