NATIONAL CORVETTE MUSEUM (NCM) REPORT

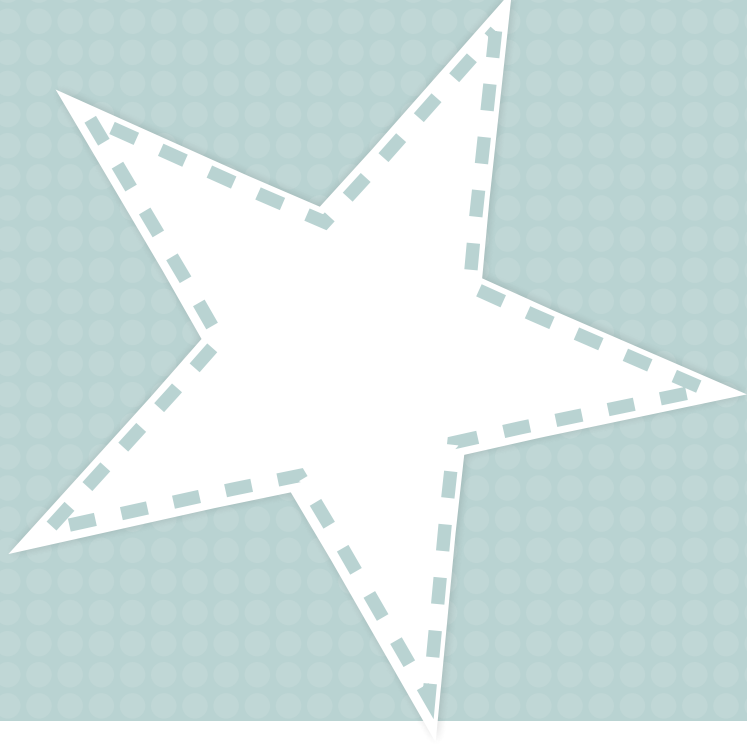
