The absentee ballot must be received in the club's post office box prior to the elections and must be signed. An election committee consisting of at least three people will be formed during the April business meeting. Nominations will open at the May business meeting. The committee will solicit and accept nominations, conduct the elections, count the ballots and turn over the results to the Secretary. Any election committee member seeking office shall not be involved in counting ballots.*

I want to point out that since we don't have a "Club post office box" any longer, I'm going to ask anyone who gets an absentee ballot to mail it to a member of the election committee, to be named by them. If you need an absentee ballot, please contact a member of our election committee. Our election committee consists of Dave Regenhardt, Rob Roth and Terry Thompson.
